Policies & Procedures

For each class, the student must have:

- Printout of class assignment (will be sent out before each class)
- Pen or pencil

Classes start promptly at 9am or 6pm. If late, the student will have to make up the time. Fifteen (15) minutes late means the student has missed the class and the class needs to be made up. Attendance is recorded daily. If the student misses a class, he/she will be given the date of the next available make-up class.

On the road driving hours will be scheduled on a first come, first served basis. The learner's permit must be with the student whenever he/she is in the driver's education car. A minimum of 24 hours notice must be given to cancel an on-the-road lesson. No flip flops when driving! Please dress appropriately for in car lessons.

No-shows and cancellations without 24-hour notice will be charged \$65.00. The fee must be paid to Liberty Driving School before the next on-the-road lesson. During some on-the-road lessons one student may pick up or drop off the next scheduled student. Per DMV regulations this is permitted with a licensed driving school instructor.

Classroom lessons are given over zoom. Students must have their camera on and I must be able to see their face. This is a DMV requirement. Classroom hours will not count for students who are not visible online. Assignments will be sent with each zoom invite email, these tests will be completed in class and signed by the student and parent. When classroom hours are complete and signed assignments will be turned in and will become part of the students file. This is also a DMV requirement.

Fee Schedule

- \$575.00 **Full Program:** 30 hours of Classroom Instruction and 8 Hours of driving lessons

Optional Services

- \$140.00 Additional Driving Lesson (2 hours).
- \$135.00 8 Hour Safe Driving Course (drug/alcohol) - this course is included in the Full Program.

Please note DMV now requires 40 hours of road training prior to testing between parents and driving school.

Payment Schedule:

Full 30 Hour Course

- **1st Payment \$300.00** Deposit (minimum amount)
- **2nd Payment \$275.00** Prior to 1st driving lesson

Any additional/optional services are due in full prior to services being rendered.

Certificates of completion (e-DEC) will not be given unless services are paid in full. An e-DEC is required for the driving test at DMV.

Preparing for your Road Test

The Full Driver's Education Course meets most of the requirements set by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles for your teen to qualify for their On-Road Driver's Test. It includes 30 hours of classroom instruction and 8 hour of Behind the Wheel training. Students will need an additional 32 hours of driving to meet the 40 hour driving requirement.

In order to ensure that your son/daughter has met the required skills and is prepared to take the exam for their Driver's License with the DMV we recommend that you space out your teens on-road lessons with us and practice with them in between.

The Behind the Wheel instructor will discuss with your teen when they feel that they will be ready for their Road Test. You can also contact us at 203-630-1040 if you have any questions or concerns about your teen's readiness to test.

Driving Students between the ages of 16 & 21 have the option of testing with DMV at our school using the Driving School car for a fee of \$85. This test is offered approximately once every other month or you can test at the DMV of your choice.
